

Three Companies Offering Commercial Support for Open Source Software Named IDC Innovators

Open source software (OSS) has grown to become one of the most widely used approaches to developing innovative new software. The ability to add new functionality and true differentiation to software applications has enabled OSS to find its way into virtually all facets of modern software. And yet, the vast majority of OSS is not available with commercial support and is frequently used as a supporting layer of or a key component of a business-critical solution.

"It's the use of OSS as the foundation for new applications that is raising the urgency for developing processes for being able to use that software safely and with the sort of support and life cycle that enterprises expect for the other software they use," said [Al Gillen](#), group vice president, Software Development and Open Source, IDC. "The innovative new business models being demonstrated by the three start-up companies highlighted in this IDC document offer examples for how OSS support may look differently in the future."

- Quansight offers support services for a sophisticated set of OSS technologies that is tightly focused on machine learning (ML) and mathematical and data science applications.

- Tidelift manages OSS developer tool and library maintenance on behalf of a customer, doing security scans and software composition analysis, helping triage issues, and ensuring enforcement of policies.
- xs:code provides a marketplace-like solution that connects enterprise customers with the creators or maintainers of the OSS projects they are using.
