

Digital Workspace Maturity Drives Business Outcomes



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Maturity Level Matrix

Organizations who participated in this study fell into four discrete maturity levels:



Problem Solvers (maturity level 1):

resolve specific problems using one or more tools well-suited to their exact need.



Tactical Managers (maturity level 2):

plan for and resolve business needs, **gaining a 108% improvement on time to deliver projects** and a **68% improvement in their ability to develop workspace solutions** over maturity level 1.



Solution Creators (maturity level 3):

create an employee experience solution using digital workspace management, gaining greater control (**21% improvement from M2** in time spent in operations) with corresponding increases in employee satisfaction and total uptime (**27% increase and 29% increase respectively**).



Digital Experience Managers (maturity level 4):

create a curated digital employee experience, and are **21.8% better at meeting the target time** for EUC projects, a **21.9% better ability to meet offboarding requirements**, and a **21.5% increase in employee satisfaction levels**.

Device Life Spans Increase Across Maturity Levels



As an organization becomes more mature, improvements in device management and uptime produce a noticeable and important improvement in overall device life span.

This can extend the upgrade life cycle for end-point devices by as much as 17 months (roughly 1.5 years) for high-maturity organizations.
